Competition Description

Carvers will be required to bring in a pre-carved sculpture and it will be set up on a pedestal that measures 2ft x 2 ft. The public will vote for their favorite sculptures to determine final placement. You may use any fruit, vegetable, spices, herbs or beans for this display. You may add props to your sculpture as long as the prop does not exceed 20% of the total sculpture (use your best judgment). You may also use any apparatus as long as it fits on the carving pedestal provided. This set up will be a timed event. Each carver will have one hour to assemble his or

her display. Carvers that can not complete their set up in the time allowed will be issued 20 minute delayed voting penalty. Props are allowed, see rules.

In addition to the pre-carved display carvers will be asked to do a demonstration of carving for one hour at the event so spectators can see you carve. These items will not go into your final display but you may use this time to interact with the crowd and explain your sculptures concept. The crowd will vote for the carvers entire display table and not just the piece the pre-carved sculpture. They will be instructed to vote for their favorite carvers overall table display. That means that this demonstration counts for voting.

Solebrate Festival will supply carvers with the fruit to be carved on site. Fruit will be Watermelons, Cantaloupe and honeydew.

Public will vote on all the art supplied by the artist, taking in account the pre-carved sculpture and the one hour demonstration piece.

Rules Pre-Carved Sculpture:

1. Bring in one sculpture that is pre-carved.
2. Sculptures will consist of at least 80% of carved food items.
3. Each competitor will be allowed to bring in their items and set them near the display site. You will only be allowed to prep your area before the timed set up begins.
4. The actual set up will be timed. You will have one hour to set up the sculpture.
5. Any apparatuses may be pre-built to save time during the set up.
6. If a carver goes over the time limit then he will be penalized by 20 minutes of delayed voting.
7. Sculpture must fit on the display tray provided. 24" x 24"
8. Chefs jackets required
9. Height limit of 48"
10. Any displays thought to be unstable or safe by judges will be required to change their original design
11. Props are allowed (up to 20% of the total sculpture) use your best judgment or call if you have a question. Props are considered to be any non-food item or not edible.

Rules 90 minute demonstration:

1. Carvers will be given watermelons, cantaloupes, honeydews according to the amount specified on their form to carve in a one hour demonstration.
2. The demonstration sculpture will not be added to the pre-carved display. It will be kept separate.
3. This display may be used to follow a theme or compliment the pre-carved sculpture.
4. Carvers may interact with the crowd and explain the them of their sculpture as well as campaign for their votes.
5. Carvers are not permitted to have any gifts on the table or handouts that would sway votes from the crowd.
6. Carvers may bring in an apparatus for this display or use toothpicks and skewers.
7. No props allowed on this display.
8. All carving must be done on site with the fruit provided.
