Amateur competition Description

Carvers will be given a watermelon, cantaloupe, honeydew and a pineapple. Carvers will have three hours to carve their display. Carvers are allowed to bring in any additional fruit, vegetables, herb, spices or beans to add to their competition piece (must be edible). There is no limit to how much you can bring in, however it must all fit on your display pedestal that measure 24" x 24". Carvers must use the fruit given to them first and that is required to be in their display.

Professional competition Description (People's Choice Judging)

Any student, judge, coach or professional carver may enter this competition. Carvers will be required to bring in a pre-carved sculpture and it will be set up on a pedestal that measures 2ft x 2 ft or 2 ft x 4 ft (let us know size preference). If you do not specify size you will receive a pedestal of 2 x 2. You may use any fruit, vegetable, spices, herbs or beans for this display. You may add props to your sculpture as long as the prop does not exceed 20% of the total sculpture (use your best judgment). You may also use any apparatus as long as it fits on the carving pedestal provided or you may make your own. If you make the stand it must be either 2 ft x 2 ft with no more than a 6 inch rise painted black or 2 ft x 4 ft with no more than a 6 inch rise painted black. This set up will be a timed event. Each carver will have one hour to assemble his or her display. Props are allowed, see rules.

In addition carvers will carve on site in a speed carving melon competition. Artists will go head to head in 12 minute speed rounds. If you are chosen as the winner by the public you will advance to the next round. There is separate prize money for speed carving. If you advance you may be carving in 3 or 4 rounds so bring some different design ideas.

**Carvers themselves will determine if they are pro or amateur. Carvers may compete in both competitions if they choose.*

Rules Amateur:

1. All carving must happen on site in the carving time allowed (3 Hours)
2. Must keep table clean and presentable to the public at all times. You are artists and professionals, so maintain a clean and organized area.
3. Must supply your own carving tools.
4. This is a freestyle event and you may carve anything you wish.
5. All cutting must be done on the cutting board provided.
6. You may only add toothpicks and skewers to display for stability. They must not be visible in the final sculpture. All other elements of the display must be from fruits, vegetable, herb, spices or beans.
7. Sculpture must fit on the display tray provided 24" x 24".
8. Please dress as professionals, chef's jackets.
9. Competitors are required to fill out waivers and application.
10. We will provide each competitor with (each one must be carved and in the final display)
 - a. One watermelon
 - b. One cantaloupe
 - c. One honey dew
 - d. One pineapple
11. Carvers may bring in any additional fruits, vegetables, herbs or spices to add to their display.

Rules for Professionals:

1. Pros will bring their sculpture in pre-carved.
2. Sculptures will consist of at least 80% of carved food items.
3. Each competitor will be allowed to bring in their items and set them near the display site. You will only be allowed to prep your area before the timed set up begins.
4. The actual set up will be timed. You will have one hour to set up the sculpture.
5. Any apparatuses may be pre-built to save time during the set up.
6. Sculpture must fit on a display pedestal that is 24" x 24" painted black. The pedestal may not be taller than six inches. You may bring your own display or use one of our pedestals. You may also use 24 x 48" pedestal, no taller than 6 inches.
7. Chefs jackets required
8. No height limit
9. Any displays thought to be unstable or safe by judges will be required to change their original design
10. Props are allowed (up to 20% of the total sculpture) use your best judgment or call if you have a question. Props are considered to be any non-food item or not edible.
11. This event will be people's choice judging
12. All carvers are required to carve in the speed watermelon carving demonstration. You will have 12 minutes to complete a watermelon.

Speed Carving Competition

1. 12 Minutes to carve
2. May use only two tools.
3. Head to head only one carver advances, decided by people's choice voting
4. Separate Prize money listed for winner and runner up
